USGA RULES

CHANGES FOR 2025

- **Ball at Rest | Ball in Motion:**
 - a) Accidentally Moving Ball During Search: No penalty for accidentally moving your ball during a search.
 - b) Ball Moved on Putting Green: No penalty for accidentally moving your ball or ball-marker on the putting green.
- **Taking Relief:**
 - a) Relief Area Size: The relief area for dropping a ball is a fixed size of either one or two club-lengths using the longest club in your bag, other than your putter.
 - b) Procedure for Dropping Ball: The ball must be let go from knee height and fall through the air without touching any part of your body or equipment.
- **Ball in Motion:**
 - a) Accidentally Deflected Ball: No penalty if your ball in motion is accidentally deflected by you, your equipment or your caddie.
- **Time for Search:**
 - a) Ball Lost Time: Your ball is lost if not found in three minutes (previously five minutes).

Pace of Play:

Keeping the Game Moving Smoothly

Golf is not only about skill and precision but also about maintaining a steady pace to ensure everyone enjoys their time on the course. Pace of play has become a crucial aspect of the game, and adhering to it benefits not just your group but everyone on the course. Here are some tips and best practices to help improve the pace of play:

1. **Be Prepared:** Always be ready to hit when it's your turn. Plan your shot while others are playing and have the right club in hand.
2. **Play Ready Golf:** Encourage "ready golf," where order of play is based on who's ready rather than who's away. This keeps the game moving without unnecessary delays.
3. **Limit Practice Swings:** Take only one or two practice swings before your shot. Excessive practice swings can slow down the pace for everyone.
4. **Keep Up with the Group Ahead:** Maintain a position close to the group in front of you. If there's an open hole in front of you, it's a sign you need to speed up.
5. **Efficient Green Play:** Read your putt while others are putting, and line up your putt quickly. Marking your ball and waiting for your turn can be done swiftly.
6. **Be Ready for Your Next Shot:** After hitting your shot, proceed directly to your ball without delay. Carry a few extra tees, balls, and your scorecard in your pocket to avoid unnecessary trips to your bag.
7. **Limit Search Time:** Adopt the new rule of limiting search time to three minutes. If you can't find your ball within this period, take a drop and keep moving.
8. **Respect Fellow Golfers:** Be mindful of the pace of play of your fellow golfers. If your group is playing slower, let faster groups play through.
9. **Utilize Technology:** Use GPS or rangefinder devices to speed up distance calculations. This can save time and help in choosing the right club quickly.
10. **Communication is Key:** Keep open communication with your playing partners about keeping up the pace. A gentle reminder can sometimes be all it takes to stay on track.

By incorporating these practices, you can contribute to a more enjoyable and efficient round of golf for everyone. Let's all work together to maintain a smooth flow on the course and uphold the spirit of the game.

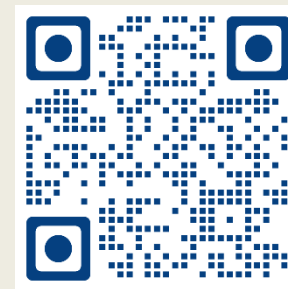
